Leader: If we have sought forgiveness for our sins from you and have not had the grace to forgive others—

If we have prayed to overcome temptation and have not trusted in the strength in your love—ALL: Lord, have mercy upon us. Christ, have mercy upon us.

Leader: If we have prayed for deliverance from evil and have not risked an unpopular witness to stand against structures of evil and iniquity—

If we have prayed for your kingdom, power and glory and have chosen instead lesser gods we have manufactured—

ALL: Lord, have mercy upon us. Christ, have mercy upon us.

Words of assurance (Based on Hebrews 12:1-2)

God gives strength to the least of God's saints. God gives us strength to set aside every weight and sin that clings so closely. God helps us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the pioneer of our faith. Amen.
